










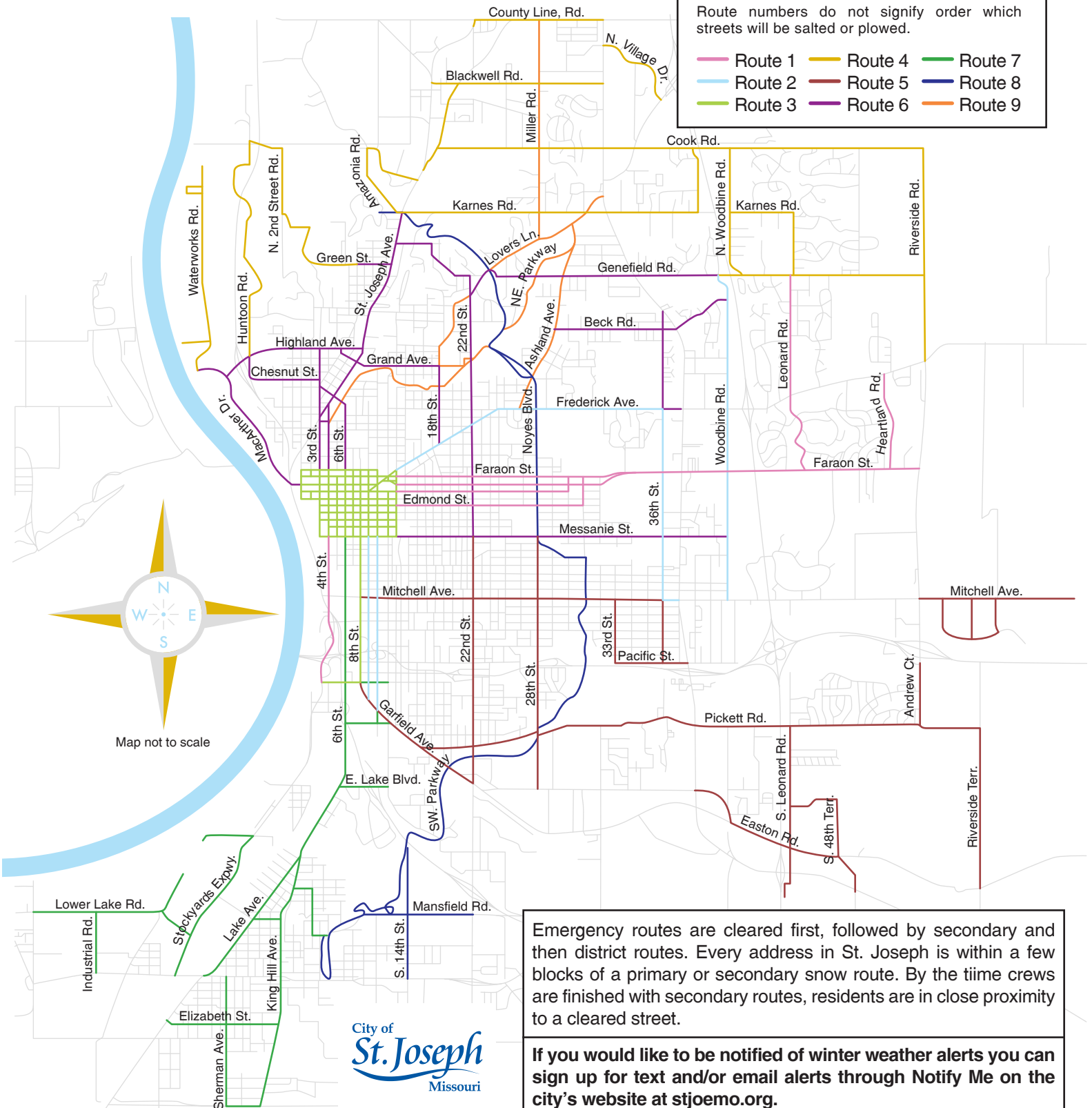
EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES

Phase II of winter weather is declared when 2.5+ inches of snow has fallen and/or a significant amount is expected. Upon declaration of Phase II, all vehicles parked on Emergency Snow Routes must be removed within two hours or they may be subject to ticketing and towing. The removal of all vehicles from emergency routes allows street crews to efficiently and effectively conduct plowing operations. Notification of Phase II will be announced through local media, the city's facebook and twitter, cable channel 19 and the city's website at stjoemo.org.

Emergency routes are cleared first, followed by secondary and then district routes. Every address in St. Joseph is within a few blocks of a primary or secondary snow route. By the time crews are finished with secondary routes, residents are in close proximity to a cleared street.
