



# Are YOU a safe driver?



The St. Joseph Police Department, in conjunction with KJO105.5/Q Country 92.7, Reed Automotive Group, Missouri Department of Transportation Highway Safety, City of St. Joseph, and the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #3, continue the "I'm a Safe Driver" program. Show us that you are a "safe driver" by completing the entry card and giving it to your SRO or turning it in at your school's office. You must possess a valid Missouri drivers license or permit to be in this program. All persons eligible will have a chance to win a car at Reed Automotive Group. The drawing will take place on Saturday, April 25, at 11 am, at Reed Automotive Group, 4525 Commons Drive.

A driving history check will be conducted on each individual whose name is drawn. Provided that you have had no traffic violations, i.e., speeding tickets, moving violation tickets, or seat belt tickets, AND no alcohol or drug related contacts since August 1, 2025, you are eligible for the drawing. If the driving record shows any of the violations listed above, you will be disqualified from the drawing. In the event that a person is disqualified, another card will be drawn.
